The Associate Sports Ministries Director is a high caliber leader who serves as a "face" of NewPointe's Sports Ministries and is primarily responsible for all ministry teams, programs, and volunteers across the ministry. This includes the role of building teams, identifying leaders, managing for quality, solving problems, championing the DNA and mission of NewPointe, and ultimately inspiring people to follow Jesus Christ.

- Oversee programming of leagues such field and team scheduling, forecasting support needs, and budget management
- Manage Sports Ministries facilities and equipment inventory
- Lead in communication with coaches
- Set the spiritual direction of Sports Ministries with coaches and players through More Than A Game program
- Integrate the Sports ministry with NP Groups, NP Kids, and NP Students ministries
- Display commitment to excellence and sensitivity to misses with a focus on identifying and exploring areas of improvement and implementing change
